

PEAC Position Statement on Reporting Impaired Pharmacists to the Officer of Inspector General

PEAC will not report cases to OIG. Pharmacists in the PEAC program may avoid Board action. Avoiding Board sanctions obviates the possibility of OIG involvement. The Maryland Duty to Report policy in the Pharmacy Practice Act [COMAR 10.34.10.05] requires reporting to PEAC violations of the pharmacy practice act that involve alcohol or substance abuse. PEAC will not report cases to the BOP unless they fail their recovery commitment and endanger the public health.
